Tasting Notes

The 2024 opens with lifted aromas of cherry and raspberry interwoven with notes of iron, warm stones, and crushed mineral, capturing the site's stony intensity. On the palate, the wine is super fresh and energized with a mouthwatering, finely chiseled structure. Pure red fruits glide across a taut, mineral spine, while polished tannins add shape without weight. Pure and electric, it finishes long, vibrant, and resonant, with a saline minerality that lingers and promises graceful evolution in bottle.

100% Cabernet Sauvignon from Beckstoffer Las Piedras Vineyard in St-Helena.

Fermented in stainless steel tanks, 3 days cold soak, 22 days on skins, aged in French oak barrels for approximately 18 months, 85% new French oak barrels, no fining.

Vice Versa has nicknamed this wine "Sleepyhead" in reference to the warm, tranquil, and hidden location of the vineyard, and so Croatian artist Paolo Čerić's label design features the face of a sleeping woman overlapped with spiral grooves, like those of a vinyl record.
